Since its inception, DreamWeek has gained unprecedented momentum. In just over ten years, the summit annually draws over 100,000 attendees to over 200 events, hosted by more than 150 hosting partners, throughout the San Antonio area. DreamWeek is concurrent with the City's annual MLK Commemorative March, which has grown to become one of the largest in the country since the first march in 1987.

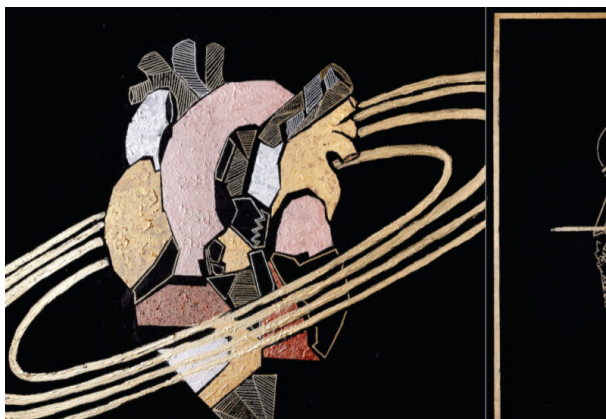

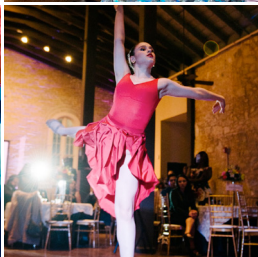
